



Privacy Policy

GHI, Inc. (also known as GHI Corp) upholds a longstanding commitment to maintain the confidentiality, integrity and security of client's personal information. The following privacy protections apply automatically to all clients.

In the course of doing business with GHI, Inc. you share personal and financial information with us. You may provide information to us when communicating with us in person, in writing, electronically, or by phone.

We treat this information as strictly confidential and recognize the importance of protecting access to it. We consider the protection of sensitive information to be a foundation of client trust and a sound business practice.

We do not sell information about current or former clients to any third parties. Further, we do not disclose client information to third parties unless it is authorized and requested by you or by your representative as part of our financial planning relationship, or as otherwise permitted by law. We maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to protect your personal information. Within GHI, Inc., we restrict access to such information only to those who require it to service your relationship.

Finally, we adhere to the SEC Board of Standards' Code of Ethics which restricts the use of client information and requires that it be held in strict confidence.

The Code of Ethics further requires that the following principles be upheld at all times:

- Integrity
- Objectivity
- Competence
- Fairness
- Confidentiality
- Professionalism
- Diligence.

In summary, GHI, Inc. agrees that all nonpublic confidential information pertaining to clients, or its assets, that it obtains by reason of existence of the financial planning relationship shall be held in confidence and shall not be disclosed without the consent of the client, except as otherwise required by applicable law.
